Message from the Chair

I would like to highlight the outstanding efforts of our members over the past year.

- In 2006, COPP members provided 376 hours of patrol coverage in East St. Paul via walking, driving and cycling. These patrols represent 792 hours of volunteer patrol time.
- When added to our administration time, the total time dedicated by members in 2006 was an outstanding 1340 hours.
- Patrol coverage increased from 12 hours in January to 53 hours in November.
- In total, 44 members completed patrols.

By-Laws Amendment

Included in this newsletter mail-out you will find a proposed amendment to our East St. Paul Citizens on Patrol By-Laws.

The amendment is proposed to up-date our By-Laws to be more consistent with the Provincial COPP and the activities of our Citizens on Patrol Group.

The proposed amendment includes two appendices:

- A) Volunteer Description
- B) Executive Portfolios

We will vote on the approval of the amendment at the **AGM** - so please plan to attend and make your vote count!

Our current By-Laws stipulate that amendments to the By-Laws require 50% plus 1 of the votes of those present at the AGM (25% of the membership must be present for a quorum).
