THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rural Municipality of East St. Paul requests the Province of Manitoba refine The Planning Act in order to make the subdivision approval process more efficient, by removing the requirement for variance approval when proposed lots do not meet the minimum Zoning By-law width and/or area requirement.
