- 7. Applicant/owner amend the Development Agreement with the RM of ESP, if required.
- 8. The Market Garden adheres to section 63.3 Performance Standards for Commercial Developments as follows:

All commercial developments:

a) shall be designed to:

convey an image of cohesive appearance and architectural character:

- Ensure that offices, reception and public use areas are easily identifiable and visible from the public roadway; and
- b) Shall be constructed and finished with durable materials to maintain the initial appearance of the development throughout the life of the project.
